The storms that threaten me.

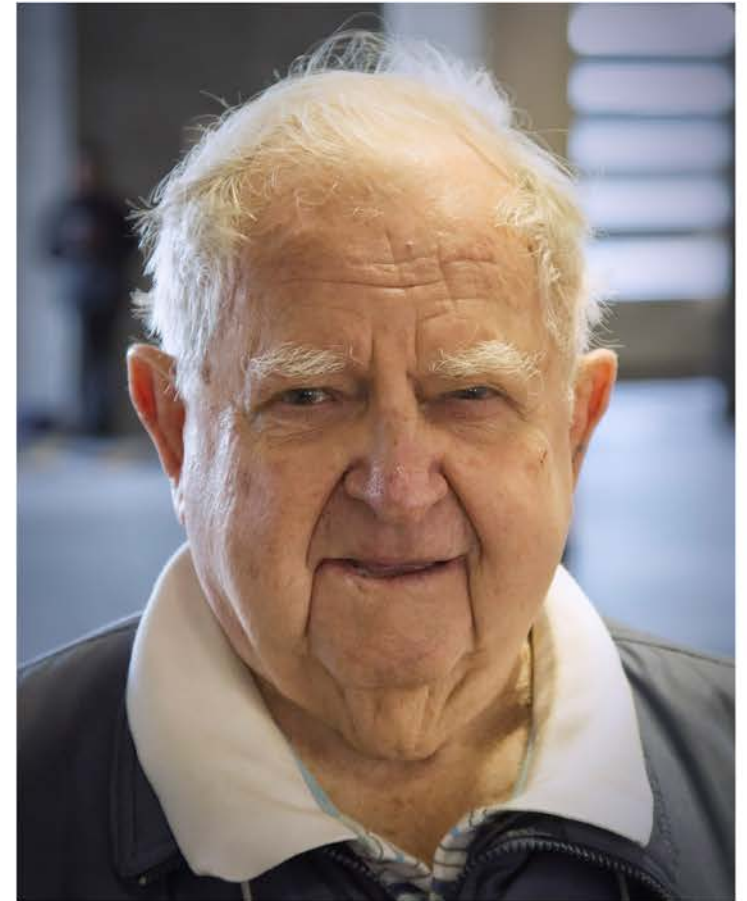
Walk with me, oh my Lord,
